**WHEREAS**, on Tuesday, February 2, 2010, Bernalillo County and Village of Corrales voters will go to the polls to decide whether to approve a \$617 million mill levy and general obligation bond project to improve and maintain the Albuquerque Public School District—one of the 30 largest school districts in our nation; and

**WHEREAS**, nearly 90,000 students are enrolled at APS's 89 elementary schools, 27 middle schools, 13 high schools, and 10 alternative schools; and

**WHEREAS**, if the funding is approved, the money will be used to build new schools, refurbish old schools (many of which are more than 40 years old), and provide exciting, new teaching technologies; and

**WHEREAS**, the additional money will result in no tax increases; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed construction projects will serve as a much needed boost to the local economy by providing jobs and furthering the educational levels of the district's students—our next generation of workers;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Bernalillo County Board of Commissioners does hereby encourage all Bernalillo County and Village of Corrales voters to support the initiative at the upcoming school mill levy and bond election and to continue to value the benefits of a well-rounded, extensive and fruitful education.
